TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Pets are welcomed at £25 per pet, per day.

This fee goes towards the deep cleaning of the room after your departure to ensure a comfortable stay for the guests after you.

Unfortunately, we are unable to welcome pets in our Deluxe or Premium rooms and there are a select few of our Standard rooms which are pet friendly.

We ask that all guests intending to bring their pet along on their stay inform the hotel in advance - this will allow us to best accommodate your V.I.P (Very Important Pet)

The hotel does retain the right to amend your reservation to accommodate any unexpected V.I.Ps.

Please Note: failure to follow our Pet Rules may result in a £250 fine and/ or being asked to leave the hotel.
